I wanted to take the time to update everyone on how the Randolph Arts Guild will be operating during the rapidly evolving Covid-19 virus health emergency.

The Randolph Arts Guild will continue limited operations while practicing recommended precautions given to us by the governor of North Carolina, such as enhanced hygiene and cleaning procedures as well as social distancing and remote communications for employees. We will have a limited work schedule and limited gallery and gift shop hours.

The following will outline our operational and programming plan for the next thirty (30) days, (March 14- April 12).

- The Randolph Arts Guild's 50th Birthday Celebration will be postponed until June
- The 2020 RAG Rummage Sale has been postponed until further notification
- The Gallery and Giftshop will be open Tuesday- Friday from 12-5p
- The Randolph Arts Guild offices will be open Monday- Friday from 12-5p
- All concerts, rentals, classes, Homeschool, Elder Arts, Kidz Art Club programming are cancelled until further notice
- April gallery show will open on April 8th. There will be no opening gallery reception, but we will showcase the exhibit on our website in a virtual exhibition. We will have a closing reception on April 29th at 5:30p.

We will continue to advocate for the arts and arts education in Randolph County so that we are prepared when this crisis is over. We hope that you all stay safe and healthy during this challenging time and we look forward to seeing you for the continued celebration of our 50th anniversary.
